

Greater Pittsburgh Community Food Bank works to host each Drive-up Food Distribution as planned. When the weather creates a health and safety risk, distributions may need to be cancelled.

## This may happen when:

- the weather is forecasted to be at or below 20 degrees from an hour prior to the event start time through the end of the distribution.
- more than one inch of snow is expected during a distribution event, including one hour prior to the scheduled start time.
- the Food Bank main warehouse in Duquesne is closed due to inclement weather.
- a Food Bank truck driver determines on route to the distribution that the roads are unsafe for travel.
- A winter storm warning is in effect by the National Weather Service on the day of a distribution.

Distributions will not be rescheduled if they are cancelled due to inclement weather.
