The Community Connections Team is your one-stop shop for the following resources:

SNAP (food stamps): The Food Bank can help you apply for this program which provides money to help purchase groceries. Income guidelines have recently increased. See if you are eligible today!

LIHEAP: The Food Bank can help you apply for LIHEAP along with a SNAP application. This program provides heating assistance.

Medical Assistance: The Food Bank can help you apply for medical assistance along with a SNAP application. This program provides healthcare coverage.

Drive-Up or Walk-In Distributions: Everyone is eligible to attend monthly food distributions throughout our service area. No registration is required.

Local Food Pantry: The Food Bank can help you find the most convenient food pantry for you.

Senior Boxes: The Food Bank can help you sign up for this program available to seniors ages 60 and over who meet income requirements. The senior box provides an additional shelf-stable box of food each month.

Food for Kids and Teens: The Food Bank can help you find afterschool and summer food meal programs for children and teenagers.

Employment Resources: The Food Bank can connect you with partners who can help with finding employment, learning new skills, resume writing and more.

Financial Wellness: The Food Bank can connect you with The Financial Empowerment Center for help with saving more money, budgeting, improving your credit score and more.

The Market: The Food Bank can connect people that visit the Food Bank's onsite pantry, called The Market, to all of these resources.
